Zagreb Tram

Zagreb has a well-developed and efficient public transport system that consists of trams, buses and trains. You can download a Tram map on this link <http://www.zet.hr/media/117298/tm3.1.2013.pdf>

A historic funicular railway (uspinjača in Croatian), one of the steepest in the world, operates between the lower and upper towns. Monthly, daily as well as single tram/bus ticket can be used, otherwise there is a small fee for a ride.

The card offers unlimited travel on public transport in Zagreb, discounts on virtually all of the city's museums, reduced prices at many restaurants, shops, and service providers and many other concessions.
